Consolidation session?

VN30 performance

The VN30-Index experienced a correction session, but the decline was insignificant, closing at 1,337 pts. Stocks in the index basket showed a mixed performance, with selling pressure observed in SHB (-1.43%), TPB (-1.22%), and BCM (-1.03%). On the other hand, capital inflows focused on SSI (+2.53%), VIC (+2.45%), GVR (+2.23%), and BID (+1.30%).

VN30 Future chart: Consolidation session?

On the daily chart, after a breakout session, the contract showed caution with a Doji-like candlestick appearing. The short upper and lower shadows suggest this might be an accumulation session. Trading volume remains high, which supports maintaining positive signals.

On the hourly chart, the contract consolidated within the 1,335-1,340-point range, forming a rectangle pattern. A breakout signal on either the upper or lower boundary is needed to confirm the next session's trend.

Technical strategy

The contract formed an accumulation phase within the 1,335-1,340-point range on the hourly chart. A breakout signal is required to confirm the next trend. Based on this signal, traders may consider opening long or short positions.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




