# Closing at a low level

#### **VN30** performance

The VN30-Index experienced its third consecutive correction session, declining by 1.68%, bringing the index down to 1,320 pts. Among the 30 component stocks, 24 declined, with 17 falling more than 1%. Significant downward pressure was seen on BVH (-3.40%), MWG (-3.30%), and TCB (-3.08%). On the other hand, only 3 stocks closed in positive territory, including PLX (+0.79%), SSB (+0.30%), and VCB (+0.11%).

### VN30 Future chart: Closing at a low level

The contract confirmed a downtrend with a sharp decline, forming a long-bodied red candlestick. Volume increased consistently over the past three sessions, indicating that capital flows supported the downtrend. Notably, the contract closed below the 10- and 20-period moving averages.

On the hourly chart, the contract confirmed the downtrend with five consecutive bearish candlesticks, along with increasing volume. However, a recovery may occur in the next session due to the significant decline at the end of last week.

#### **Technical strategy**

Negative signals have confirmed a short-term downtrend. Therefore, traders may consider opening short positions in the next session. Additionally, a technical recovery may occur before the contract continues its correction; investors can consider taking advantage of this to maximize profits.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




