# Improved liquidity

### **VN30** performance

The VN30-Index posted a recovery session, but the gain was relatively weak, rising by 0.16% to 1,337 points. Notably, capital inflows focused on GVR (+2.43%), POW (+2.10%), VHM (+1.97%), PLX (+1.57%), and VRE (+1.52%). On the other hand, selling pressure appeared in MWG (-2.84%) and FPT (-1.31%).

## **VN30 Future chart: Improved liquidity**

On the daily chart, the contract closed above the 10- to 50-period moving averages, indicating a positive signal for the trend. However, over the past four sessions, the market has shown signs of accumulation. Therefore, a breakout session above or below the current range is necessary to confirm the next trend.

On the hourly chart, the contract consolidated within the 1,327–1,340 point range. A breakout above or below this range is required to determine the next direction.

#### **Technical strategy**

The contract formed an accumulation phase within the 1,327–1,340 point range. Investors should wait for a breakout signal above or below this range to confirm either an uptrend or downtrend. Based on this signal, investors may open long or short positions.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




