# **Declining liquidity**

### **VN30** performance

The VN30-Index recorded its third consecutive session of growth, though the increase was modest at 0.09%, reaching 1,391 points. BCM was the highlight of the session as it hit the ceiling price. Additionally, capital inflows were directed toward VIC (+4.42%), VCB (+1.79%), and HDB (+1.28%). On the other hand, selling pressure was observed in LPB (-1.69%) and FPT (-1.49%).

## **VN30 Future chart: Declining liquidity**

On the daily chart, although the contract maintained its upward momentum, selling pressure emerged. The decline in liquidity suggests a possible increase in caution. However, no negative signals have appeared yet, as the index remains above key moving averages. The 1,400-point level could act as strong resistance for the current uptrend.

On the hourly chart, the contract appears to be forming an accumulation phase within a narrow range. However, the pattern is not yet clearly defined. The 10-period moving average will likely serve as support in the next session, maintaining the current upward trend.

#### **Technical strategy**

Despite a slight slowdown, the contract continues to confirm an uptrend based on previous signals. Therefore, traders may consider identifying suitable entry points to open long positions in the upcoming session.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




