Profit-taking pressure?

VN30 performance

The VN30-Index returned to a correction phase, declining by 0.45% to 1,388 points. Notably, eight stocks dropped by over 1%, with selling pressure focusing on VPB (-1.98%), MBB (-1.65%), and VIC (-1.54%). Conversely, buying demand appeared on SHB (+3.11%), LPB (+2.02%), and GAS (+1.32%).

VN30 Future chart: Profit-taking pressure?

On the daily chart, the contract corrected after surpassing the Mar 2025 peak. Trading volume continued to decline, implying cautious investor sentiment. This also reinforced the possibility of an ongoing accumulation phase observed over the last five sessions. Additionally, the 1,400-point level remains a significant resistance level for the upward trend.

On the hourly chart, the contract maintained its consolidation within a narrow range between 1,384 and 1,393 points. Therefore, a clear breakout signal is required to confirm the trend direction in the upcoming period.

Technical strategy

The futures contract remains in consolidation within the range of 1,384–1,393 points. Traders should wait for a clear breakout signal to confirm the next trend direction before deciding to open long or short positions.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




