Downward trend?

VN30 performance

The VN30Index continued its correction, declining by 0.79% to 1,377 points. Strong selling pressure emerged notably on FPT (-4.15%) and MWG (-3.72%). Additionally, six other stocks declined by less than 1%, including VPB, MSN, BCM, HPG, TPB, and CTG. On the contrary, buying interest appeared on GVR (+4.19%), LPB (+1.55%), and VIC (+1.17%).

VN30 Future chart: Downward trend?

On the daily chart, the contract closed at the day's lowest point, signaling short-term selling pressure. Moreover, increased trading volume in yesterday's session indicated rising selling momentum. The futures contract confirmed a double-top pattern with a target range of 1,370–1,375 points.

On the hourly chart, the contract declined below the support level of 1,384 points, confirming a rectangle pattern. The target price from this rectangle pattern coincides with the double-top pattern mentioned earlier, implying that the downward trend may continue.

Technical strategy

The contract formed a clear downtrend by confirming a double-top pattern. Traders should remain cautious and closely observe market developments, as increasing volatility could reduce the reliability of forecasts.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




