Breakout session

VN30 performance

The VN30Index recovered, rising 0.90% to close at 1,390 points. Stocks from the VinGroup ecosystem led the market, notably VIC (+6.98%), VHM (+6.32%), and VRE (+3.79%). In addition, other stocks attracted inflows, including SHB (+5.53%), TCB (+2.38%), and SSI (+2.07%). On the contrary, selling pressure appeared on LPB (-1.87%), BCM (-1.78%), and VIB (-1.72%).

VN30 Future chart: Breakout session

On the daily chart, the contract recorded a breakout session driven by strong buying interest at lower price levels. Notably, trading volume increased again, signaling positive momentum. Furthermore, the contract returned to close above key moving averages, suggesting the potential for the upward trend to resume.

On the hourly chart, the contract formed a strong bullish candlestick at the session's end, confirming a possible return to the upward trend. However, additional clear signals remain necessary to conclude that the recent correction ended, as selling pressure could reappear around the previous resistance level of 1,390-1,400 points.

Technical strategy

Signals turned positive following the recent breakout session. However, traders should remain cautious and closely monitor market developments before reopening positions, as selling pressure might emerge again at the previous resistance zone of 1,390-1,400 points.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




