Bearish sentiment

VN30 performance

The VN30Index had a historic trading session, plunging 6.81% after the U.S. announced high reciprocal tariffs on Vietnamese products. As a result, the index corrected to 1,283 points, with selling pressure hitting all index constituents. Notably, 28 out of 30 stocks hit the floor, except for SSB (-2.60%) and VNM (-6.61%).

VN30 Future chart: Bearish sentiment

On the daily chart, the futures contract formed a long-bodied candlestick accompanied by a surge in trading volume. This signals strong selling pressure, especially as the index broke below the Jan 2025 bottom. With this signal, the downtrend has been confirmed.

However, in the upcoming session, the contract may experience a intraday rebound before continuing its downtrend, given the sharp drop in the previous session. The 1,240-1,250 zone will serve as a strong support level in the next session.

Technical strategy

The contract has confirmed a downtrend following yesterday's sharp decline. Therefore, traders may consider maintaining short positions in the coming sessions, while also taking advantage of any intraday rebound to initiate new positions.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




