Liquidity declined

VN30 performance

The VN30Index recorded its second consecutive correction session, though the decline was minimal at just 0.01%, and the index still closed around the 1,409-point level. Accordingly, selling pressure emerged in BCM (-1.51%), PLX (-1.29%), MSN (-1.25%), TCB (-1.15%), and VPB (-1.09%). On the other hand, capital inflows were observed in GAS (+3.28%), STB (+1.70%), VRE (+1.18%), ACB (+1.17%), and VHM (+1.03%).

VN30 Future chart: Liquidity declined

On the daily chart, the contract formed a candlestick with a small body and declining volume, indicating short-term caution. However, this is not a bearish signal, as the index still closed above key moving averages such as the 10-, 20-, and 50-day lines.

Furthermore, after breaking through a key resistance level (the Mar 2025 peak around 1,400 points), a throwback phase is considered normal. Therefore, the uptrend may still be sustained.

Technical strategy

Short-term risks may increase as upward momentum pauses and volume stays low. Traders should stay cautious, monitor the market closely, and wait for the next signal before opening new positions.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




