# Waiting for the next signal

## **VN30** performance

Following a sharp decline in the previous session, the VN30-Index rebounded by 0.59% to close at 1,630 points. Bank stocks emerged as the key market drivers, with VPB and SHB hitting their daily upper limits. In addition, capital flowed into CTG (+5.48%), VIB (+4.31%), TPB (+3.92%), STB (+2.71%), and MBB (+2.05%). On the other hand, selling pressure was observed in SSB (-3.27%) and VIC (-3.27%).

## VN30 Future chart: Waiting for the next signal

On the daily chart, although the contract showed signs of recovery, it still reflected caution among investors, as indicated by a candlestick with a long lower shadow and a small body. This suggests the corrective phase may continue over the next few sessions.

However, this consolidation period may end soon, given the increase in bottomfishing demand yesterday, coupled with improved liquidity and strong support around the 20-day moving average. Therefore, it remains important to watch for potential reversal signals in the coming sessions.

### **Technical strategy**

While investor sentiment remains cautious, the downtrend may soon come to an end as liquidity improved in the previous session. As such, traders are advised to closely monitor the market and wait for appropriate long entry points.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




