Profit-taking pressure

VN30 performance

After five consecutive gaining sessions, the VN30-Index recorded a correction, though the decline was limited at 0.07%, closing at 1,875 points. Selling pressure was concentrated in VJC (-2.47%), VIC (-2.03%), MSN (-1.92%), and VIB (-1.86%). On the other hand, buying interest emerged in VNM (+2.54%), MBB (+2.42%), SAB (+2.36%), and SHB (+2.25%).

VN30 Future chart: Profit-taking pressure

On the daily chart, profit-taking pressure led to a correction; however, the uptrend remained intact as the contract closed above the 10-day and 20-day moving averages.

That said, correction risks may return as trading volume increased in the previous session. Although the rise was not significant, it still served as a warning signal that requires monitoring. In addition, with the contract set to expire in two sessions, short-term risks also increased.

Technical strategy

While the uptrend remains in place in the short term, risks have started to emerge. Investors should act cautiously, observe the market, and wait for confirmation signals before reopening positions.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




