Momentum slowing

VN30 performance

The VN30Index recorded its fifth consecutive gain; however, the upward momentum slowed as the index rose only 0.07%, closing at 2,013 points. The highlight was VJC, which hit the ceiling price. In addition, capital inflows were also seen in VIC (+3.16%), VPB (+2.52%), VHM (+2.25%), and MWG (+1.45%). On the other hand, selling pressure appeared in MSN (-2.94%), GVR (-2.28%), HPG (-2.24%), CTG (-2.16%), and BID (-2.10%).

On the daily chart, the contract formed a candlestick similar to a Doji, reflecting investor caution. The increase in trading volume during this session indicated profit-taking pressure, suggesting a short-term consolidation phase after strong rallies in previous sessions.

The short-term uptrend remains intact as the contract continued to close above the 10-day and 20-day moving averages. In addition, the index remained above the 2,000-point threshold.

At present, the contract has reached the first target price of the rectangle pattern near 2,000 points, while the next potential target lies around 2,200 points.

Technical strategy

Although the upward momentum slowed in the previous session, the market still confirmed its short-term uptrend. Therefore, traders may consider reopening long positions and taking advantage of intraday pullbacks to optimize profits.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




