Bullish piercing pattern

VN30 performance

After two consecutive correction sessions, the VN30Index recorded a strong rebound, rising 2.55% to close at 1,949 points. A total of 28 out of 30 constituents advanced, led by VJC, which hit the upper limit. Buying interest also flowed into FPT (+4.29%), VIB (+4.07%), VPB (+4.06%), and STB (+4.03%). In contrast, selling pressure appeared on PLX (-0.29%).

VN30 Future chart: Bullish piercing pattern

On the daily chart, positive signals are returning as the market forms a Bullish Piercing Pattern, a bullish reversal candlestick formation. Additionally, trading volume remains elevated, suggesting that an upward trend may be regaining momentum.

However, this rebound could still represent a bull trap, as selling pressure remains strong around the 10-day moving average, which will likely act as a key resistance level in the coming sessions.

Meanwhile, the 1,800-point zone continues to serve as strong short-term support.

Technical strategy

Current technical signals lack consistency, so traders should stay cautious and wait for clearer confirmation of the trend before reopening new positions.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




