# **Correction below 1,900 points**

### **VN30** performance

The VN30Index continued its fourth consecutive declining session with intensified selling pressure. Accordingly, the index fell sharply by 2.98% to 1,867 points. Twenty-nine constituent stocks declined, with the spotlight on VRE and VHM, both of which hit their daily limit-down. Additionally, 25 other stocks declined by over 1%, notably VPB (-5.68%), GVR (-5.07%), HDB (-4.88%), MWG (-4.62%), and VIB (-4.42%). On the opposite side, only one stock posted gains: BCM (+0.15%).

### VN30 Future chart: Correction below 1,900 points

On the daily chart, market sentiment turned pessimistic with the third consecutive sharp decline. The contract closed below key short-term moving averages, including the 10-period, 20-period, and 50-period moving averages.

The contract closed below the 1,900-point level accompanied by volume sustained at elevated levels. This confirms that a short-term downtrend has formed. In the next session, the 1,900-point level will serve as strong resistance, while the 1,850-point level will represent important support.

#### **Technical strategy**

The short-term downtrend receives confirmation with volume sustained at high levels. Therefore, traders should exercise caution and may consider opening short positions.


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Figure 1. VN30 Generics daily chart





Figure 2. Basis spread





Figure 4. Open interest pattern




