Sustained upward momentum

VN30 performance

The VN30Index continued to rise with a strong breakthrough session, surging 1.98% to reach 2,096 points. Twenty-eight out of 30 constituent stocks of the index posted gains, with focal points including PLX, GVR, BCM, and GAS, all of which hit their ceiling prices. On the contrary, selling pressure only appeared on two stocks: STB (-5.82%) and VJC (-1.23%).

VN30 Future chart: Sustained upward momentum

On the technical chart, the market experienced its second breakthrough session and formed a new all-time high. Additionally, although volume did not increase, it remained at high levels, indicating that the uptrend has been confirmed again.

Furthermore, the contract still closed above important short-term moving averages such as the 10-period, 20-period, and 50-period moving averages. The Momentum indicator group has not yet shown warning signals about potential peak formation, so the contract will continue to rise in upcoming sessions.

In the next session, the 2,100-point threshold will serve as strong resistance while the 2,000-point zone will act as strong support.

Technical strategy

With the second breakthrough session, the uptrend continues to be confirmed. Therefore, traders can reopen long positions and take advantage of correction phases to optimize profits.

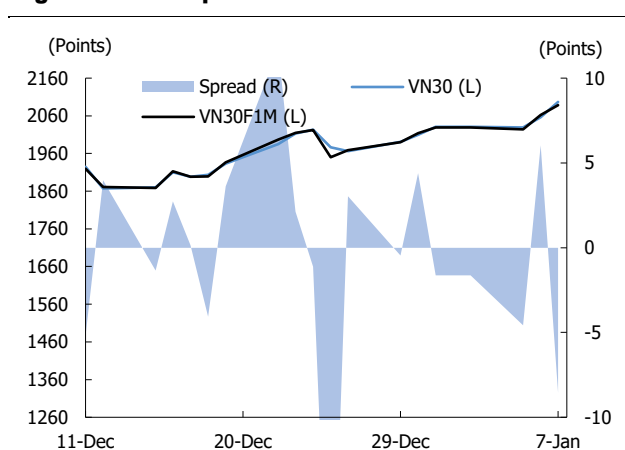

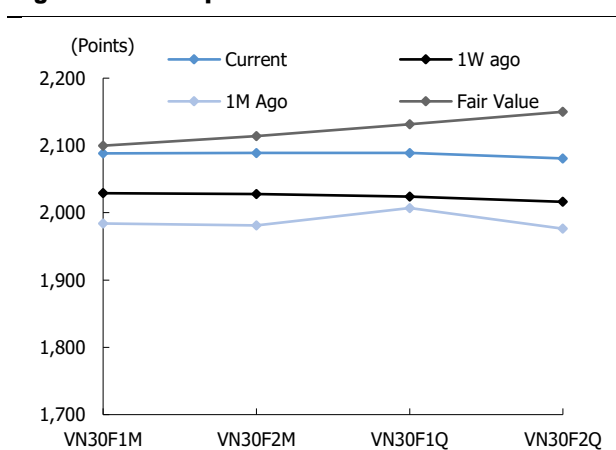

Figure 1. VN30F1M Generics daily chart

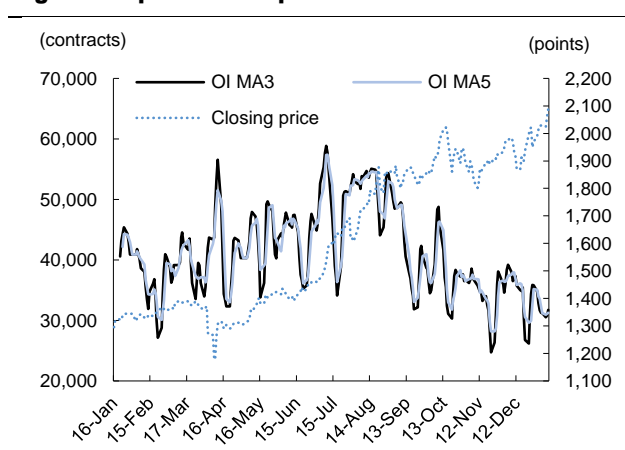

Figure 2. Basis spread

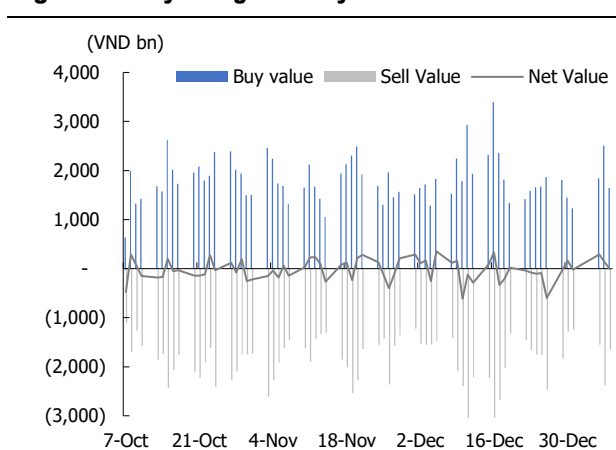
