# Buy signal

## VN30 performance

The VN30 Index made a recovery, rising 0.98% to 1,829 points. Capital flow showed a tendency to move into stocks such as VIC (+4.25%), MBB (+2.72%), VPB (+2.30%), DGC (+2.24%), and TPB (+2.19%). In addition, four other stocks - STB, CTG, SSI, and MWG - recorded gains of over 1%. On the downside, selling pressure emerged on GVR (-4.23%), GAS (-3.09%), and PLX (-2.42%).

## VN30 Future chart: Buy signal

The contract generated a buy signal after it broke above the 10-period moving average. This is a significant signal that suggests a short-term uptrend could return, even without an increase in trading volume.

However, additional confirmation signals warrant close monitoring, as the contract still closed below both the 20-period and 50-period moving averages. Furthermore, selling pressure appeared at the 20-period moving average, which produced a candlestick with a long upper shadow.

In the next session, the 1,840-1,850 point range serves as strong short-term resistance, while the 1,720-1,750 point range acts as strong support.

## Technical strategy

A buy signal has appeared in the short term. Traders may consider re-entering long positions. Nevertheless, caution is advised should a reversal signal emerge.


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**Figure 1. VN30F1M Generics daily chart**





**Figure 2. Basis spread**





**Figure 3. Future price curve**




